Retain basic information and adapt to your own style (Feb 2023, v2)

VE3STP is an open repeater, whose priorities are emergency, public service, mobile and rag-chew.

This is a controlled net. All traffic enquiries with other stations and any other business should be handled via the net controller.

All Stations are welcome to check in. Again net controller is {callsign} the name is {name – spelled phonetically}

- Second of last calls, and
- Third and final call.

Following the final call for check-ins please provide the following report to the STP Net Manager either on-air or by email of the day and date of the Net, # of check-ins, # of Emergency, Priority or Formal Traffic, and # of informal or other traffic as well as the total number of minutes in session. (e.g., For Thursday February 16th, please record 13 check-ins, 0 formal/priority traffic , 5 informal traffic exchanges and 53 minutes in session).
